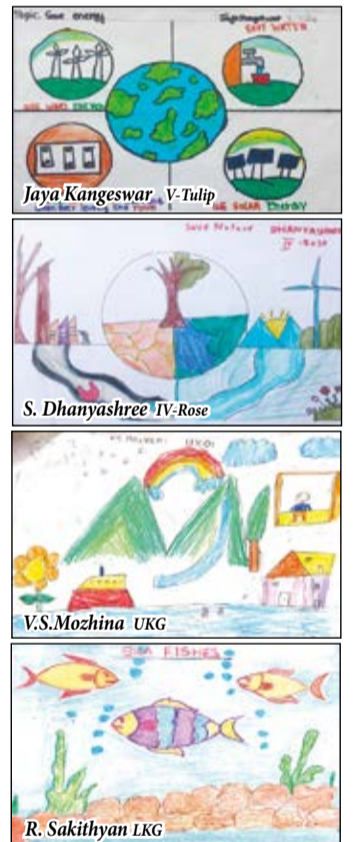
into the traditional form of puppetry. Through puppet shows, he has been spreading meaningful messages and preserving cultural heritage among people.

Dengue Awareness Week

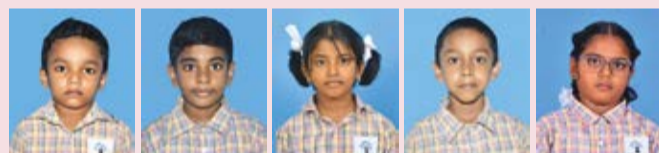

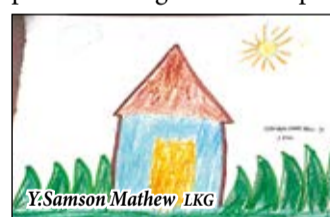
